- Cur síos idir 100 agus 200 focal a scríobh maidir leis an bhfógra agus é a chur chugainn leis an bhfíseán ag www.foinse.ie/bng

- Caithfidh na físeáin a bheith níos lú ná 20MB

Céard í Bliain na Gaeilge?
